- 1–4 years of relevant work experience managing field-based empirical research projects
- Resourceful, detail-oriented, and capable of taking ownership of tasks
- Excellent organizational skills, with the ability to prioritize assignments, maintain workflow, and meet critical deadlines
- Capacity to multi-task—working on a variety of tasks simultaneously, adjusting to priorities, and delivering results in line with agreed objectives
- Advanced computer skills (MS Excel, Word, PowerPoint, etc.) to produce clear, highimpact visual presentations of research findings for diverse audiences and stakeholders
- Ability to work independently, collaborate remotely, and travel as required for fieldwork
- Prior experience conducting randomized controlled trials (RCTs) and/or a postgraduate degree will be considered an advantage
